**WHAT ARE WE BUILDING?**

A recreational facility that will be able to provide space for each of the ministries that Parkside provides. The ROC will be open for use by each and every church member as a place of outreach to the community we serve. It will span the generations and serve as a place to make real connections for the people that enter its doors. The vision for The ROC is to enhance current and future ministries and programs by providing outreach in ways we've never been able to before, in a building that expands our current limitations. The extra space will equip us to better offer:

- Recreational events
- Senior-adult gatherings
- Youth activities
- Children's Ministry opportunities
- Full church-wide banquets
- Fellowship space to be enjoyed with friends and family

**WHY ARE WE BUILDING IT?**

After prayerful and intensive research, the Strategic Long-Range Planning Committee recommended that Parkside needed a facility that would help us reach out to those in our community. The recommendation was that we build a flexible, multi-functional facility. From that recommendation, the church voted to support the plan to build The ROC (Recreational Outreach Center).

**WHEN WILL WE OCCUPY THE NEW FACILITY?**

The plan is to open The ROC in December of 2009.

**HOW MUCH WILL THE NEW FACILITY COST?**

There are many questions about the funding for this facility. Please see the attached letter from the Parkside Finance Committee that addresses those questions.

**WHAT IS A CAPITAL STEWARDSHIP CAMPAIGN?**

Capital Stewardship Campaign is a church project that seeks pledged donations from members of the congregation to be used in paying for a major construction project; in our case, a new facility. Parkside is in Phase 2 of a Capital Stewardship Campaign.

**IF I CAN'T GIVE A LARGE AMOUNT, DOES MY PLEDGE REALLY MATTER?**

Absolutely! All pledges matter, regardless of amount, because as we all participate according to our ability, God multiplies our giving.

**WHEN ARE WE EXPECTED TO GIVE THE AMOUNT PLEDGED?**

Pledge cards will be turned in on Commitment Sunday, and pledges will begin to be received shortly thereafter.

**WHAT FORMS OF CONTRIBUTIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED?**

Contributions can be made by cash or check. Other forms of contributions can include the transference of title to marketable stocks, bonds, real estate, etc.

**MAY I UPDATE MY COMMITMENT AFTER CELEBRATION SUNDAY?**

Yes. You may update your commitment at any time.

**DO YOU HAVE TO BE A CHURCH MEMBER TO PARTICIPATE IN THE CAMPAIGN?**

No. Participating in the campaign is a personal decision for each of us, and anyone may contribute to God's work in our church.
